



Peanut Harvest Aid



Aim® EC herbicide may be applied to peanuts to defoliate and/or desiccate troublesome broadleaf weeds such as morningglory and pigweed. The objective of a harvest aid is to desiccate or dry down weed and/or crop vegetation to make harvest more efficient and timely.

Application Guidelines

- Application should be made when crop is mature and within 14 days of harvest.
- 7 Day Pre - Harvest Interval
- Use Rate: 1.0 to 2.0 oz/A Aim EC
- Use spray adjuvant:
 - NIS at 0.25% v/v (2 pints per 100 gallons of spray solution)
 - COC at 1-2% v/v (1-2 gallons per 100 gallons of spray solution)
- Coverage is essential for satisfactory performance.
- Apply in a minimum of 10 gallons per acre by ground or 5 gallons per acre by air.
- May be tankmixed with other registered harvest aid products to broaden spectrum.



Peanut leaf burn or spotting has been observed within 2 days after the application of Aim and may be more evident with high temperatures and high humidity.



Aim provides excellent morningglory desiccation.
